Meet some of the camp guides

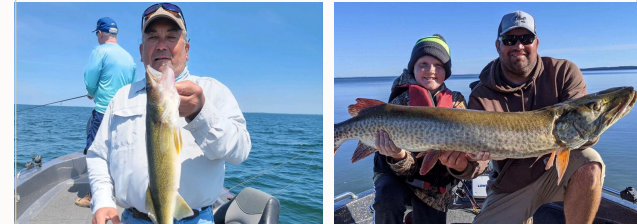
AUSTIN MICHAUD
